

**ORDINANCE 2021-**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF DAYTON CHAPTER 52.06: TAP PERMIT**

WHEREAS, in 1996 the Town Council of the Town of Dayton amended Chapter 52.06 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Dayton concerning Tap Permits; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Dayton seeks to amend Chapter 52.06 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Dayton and said amendments are attached as Exhibit A:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, that the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Dayton be amended by repealing existing Chapter 52.06 and replacing it with a new Chapter 52.06 as follows:

**ADOPTING TAP PERMIT ORDINANCE 52.06 BY REFERENCE**

(A) The Tap Permit Ordinance for the Town of Dayton, Indiana, as amended in Exhibit A, is incorporated by reference as part of this chapter and it is hereby enacted and adopted and approved as a general ordinance of the Town of Dayton.

(B) Two copies of the Tap Permit Ordinance for the Town of Dayton, Indiana, as amended, are on file in the office of the Town Clerk-Treasurer for public inspection.

(C) The Town Council and/or the Utility Service Board shall be responsible for implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance supersedes all prior ordinances regarding Tap Permits.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and signing and publication as required by law.

## **Exhibit A**

### **§ 52.06 TAP PERMIT.**

(A) Prior to making any tap into the conduit mains of the town or connecting any service lateral thereto, the owner or his or her agent shall make application therefore to the town upon forms furnished therefor. The application shall be accompanied by plans, specifications, plat plan showing the location of the service lateral and point of connection to the waterworks, and any additional information that the Board or Superintendent may require. Except for owners in Prestwick Manor subdivision, a connection fee in the amount of \$400 for a tap of five-eighths-inch diameter shall be paid to the Utility Service Board at the time the application is filed. If the tap is greater than five-eighths inches, the fee shall be the cost of time and material in addition to \$400. A permit and inspection fee of \$25 shall be paid to the Utility Service Board at the time the application is filed. In Water V-11 addition the owner shall pay to the Utility Service Board the sum of \$35 as deposit for use as hereinafter provided. The Superintendent shall issue the permit within seven days of filing of the application, or within the time notify the owner or his or her agent what is additionally required before the permit will be issued.

(B) The connection to the town waterworks shall conform to the requirements of the building and plumbing code, any conditions on the permit, and other applicable rules and regulations of the town.

(C) The owner or his or her agent shall notify the Superintendent or the Clerk-Treasurer prior to covering any excavation when the connection is ready to be made. The connection shall be under the supervision of the Superintendent, who shall also inspect the service lateral and approve same.

(D) All excavations for service lateral shall be adequately guarded with barricades and lights so as to protect the public from hazards. Streets, sidewalks, parkways and other public property disturbed in the course of the work shall be restored in a manner satisfactory to the town.
