Adjustment Report

BF&S

Colin Sullivan and Chris Limiac were present to represent BF&S. Chris summarized the SIA project progress. Discussion followed.

Marc made a motion to accept the SIA approval. Carla seconded. Roll call vote. Marc-yes, Stan-yes, Jen-yes, Carla-yes, Ron-yes. 5-0

They will send a letter for the town to sign.

They had looked into extending water service to the police station and west of that. They had two proposals and outlined them for the council. A cost for a study to determine costs to extend to the police station only would be \$3200. Discussion followed.

Cindy Marsh 749 Shady Lane pointed out that per the town's Development Guide anyone who wanted to develop land past the police station would have to pay to extend the utilities.

The council decided to table the issue for now.

Colin advised that the road work would start in September.
