## **Adjustment Report:**

# **Utility Superintendent Report:**

**Sheffield Township Fire/Insurance Service Rating-** November 15<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 Mark will meet with the insurance company and Shawn Alkire. This is done every 5 years.

**Fall List Station Maintenance-** Spring and Fall maintenance is complete each year with a cost of \$1500 each time. Mark will be scheduling the Fall maintenance this month.

Fall Grease Trap/Oil and Grit Chamber Inspections- These are required in the Spring and the Fall in our agreement with Lafayette Renew. The Fall inspection has been completed.

**2021 CCMG Project Status/Billing-** Mark read an email from BF&S stating that Midwest Paving is going to replace park of the sidewalk in question. One invoice was submitted for work that included concrete work and driveway approaches; this invoice totaled \$52,423.96. Invoice #2 was for asphalt work in the amount of \$207,860.03. Invoice #3 was requesting release of the 10% retainage in the amount of \$28,920.44.

Of the first invoice totaling \$52,423.96, \$29,827.70 was the cost for the church sidewalk that is being replaced.

The total of all three invoices total \$289,204.43.

Mark and BF&S recommend that the town does not release that 10% because they are not satisfied with the work completed. Mark also recommended subtracting the \$29,827.70 for the church's sidewalk until it is fixed to the town's satisfaction.

When subtracting the \$29,827.70 for the sidewalk and \$28,920.44 for the 10% retainage from the total \$289,204.43, the amount suggested to pay is \$230,456.29.

Ashley Stevenson made a motion to pay Midwest Paving \$230,456.29...Jen Manago seconded the motion...carried roll call vote 5-0.

**2022 CCMG Call for Projects-** Next call for projects is January 3-28, 2022. Mark spoke with the council regarding when they wanted to subject projects, either in January or July 2022. Ron stated that he thought that they should apply for the January round. Mark asked Stan to take lead on getting the projects together based on the street rating list. Mark suggested that the council have a list together to send to BF&S by December 13<sup>th</sup> board meeting.

**Kelly's Landscaping Services-** Per contract, they are requesting first payment for the leaf pickup of \$2000.

Michelle addressed the board about Mark needing a new computer. It currently doesn't turn on. Due to the amount of work he does and the file sizes, the current computer that he hasn't doesn't have the storage capacity that he needs for his job.
