Adjustment Report: Rocky made a motion to accept the Adjustment Report for 01/01/26 through 01/31/2026. Steve seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mike- yes, Rocky- yes, Steve- yes, Marc- yes, Carla- yes. Motion carried 5-0.

Town Manager: Kurt Delzer presented the M. E. Simpson Company, Inc. Proposal & Contractor Agreement for the 2026 Fire Hydrant Maintenance and Flushing Program with a fee to be \$9,350.00. (\$2,950.00 per day x 3 days). They were 98% sure they would be done in 2 days. If they work only ½ a day they would still charge \$2,950.00. Kurt said if they did not finish with all the hydrants in 2 days he could finish the rest. Marc made a motion to accept the Contract but not to exceed the proposed amount of \$9,350.00. Steve seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mike- yes, Rocky- yes, Steve- yes, Marc- yes, Carla- yes. Motion carried 5-0.

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Kurt asked on behalf of Cindy, since she was not in attendance, that the council approve \$2,350.00 for flowers & mulch for the landscaping around the Town Hall building and the Gazabo. Marc made the motion to approve the \$2,350.00. Mike seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mike- yes, Rocky- yes, Steve- yes, Marc- yes, Carla- yes. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

- **Trash Kans Contract:** After discussion, the Council agreed to automatically extend the Trash Kans Contract for an additional two (2) year term from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2028. No motion or vote required to let the contract automatically extend.

Water Project Discussion – Council decided to table the discussion until next month’s meeting.

Public Comment: Ron Kohler addressed the council regarding the Trash Kan contract. He said that he used to oversee the Trash Kan account. He felt they did have some problems but basically were a good provider. He suggested that the town get bids from other providers to possibly get a lower price.
