Utility Board President Carla Snodgrass called the Utility Board meeting to order. In attendance were Board President, Marc Buhrmester, Vice President, Rocky Richards, Utility Vice President, Leah Copass, Council Member, Steve Schuhle, Cler Treasurer, Bridget Cadwallader, Town Attorney, Alicia Albertson, and Deputy Marshal Tislow.

Baker Farms Emergency Road:

Mike Smith of BF&S spoke about the damage to Baker Farms Emergency Road. The road is closed currently because of the damage. Council discussed who would be liable for the damages and how to prove who is liable. At this time the council asked BF&S to get a cost of repairs for the road.

Bridget asked the council to vote on the new meter system from Neptune at a cost of \$22,000.00. The new system will be able to give us daily readings, making it easier to find water leaks. The software will cost an additional \$1500 per year. The system is to be paid for by ARP funds.

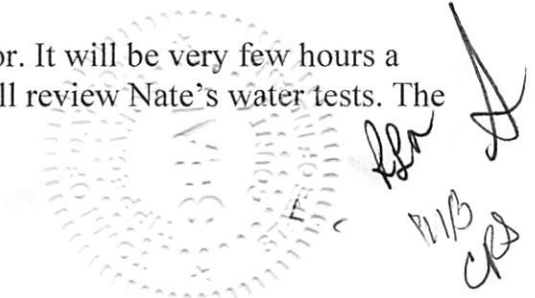

Carla updated the council on the search for a Certified Water Operator. It will be very few hours a month, so they are looking for someone affordable. The Operator will review Nate's water tests. The goal is to have someone hired by April 1, 2024.

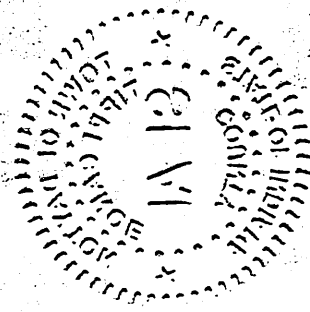
