Utility Board President Carla Snodgrass called the Utility Board meeting to order. In attendance were Marc Buhrmester, Rocky Richards, Leah Copas, Carla Snodgrass, Steve Schuhle, Bridget Cadwallader, Alicia Albertson, and Marshal Taylor.

Pat Williams from the Tippecanoe County Extension Office spoke about the community garden. This is something we will begin in the fall of this year.


Trash bids were read from trash contractors. Marc opened the bids. T&L Disposal in the amount of \$8418.90 per month. The second bid was from Trash Kans, our current trash contract, in the amount of \$8835.00 per month. Marc made a motion to take it under advisement and Leah seconded it. Roll call vote. Steve-yes, Leah-yes, Rocky-yes, Marc-yes, Carla-yes. Motion carried 5-0.

The Town Manager asked the council to approve the supplies needed to get the new meter system up & running in the amount of \$2,425.00. After a discussion Marc made a motion to approve these purchases in the amount of \$2,425.00 and Carla seconded the motion. Roll call vote. Steve-yes, Leah-yes, Rocky-yes, Marc-yes, Carla-yes. Motion carried 5-0.

Carla received information from Duke Energy on a light proposal. Leah will contact Duke Energy to get clarifications on this proposal.

BF&S spoke about Dayton's Growth Plan with the issue of water pressure to the outer areas of Dayton. A motion was made by Steve and seconded by Leah to hire a grant writer to apply for the OCRA Grant to pay for a study of the water pressure issue. Roll call vote. Carla-yes, Marc-yes, Rocky-yes, Leah-yes, Steve-yes. Passed 5-0.

Carla made a motion to approve an Independent Contractor contract who is a Certified Water Operator for \$500.00 a month to oversee the water testing. He will work with Nate to ensure our water testing is up to standard per IDEM. Steve seconded the motion. Roll call vote. Rocky-yes, Leah-yes, Steve-yes, Carla-yes, Marc-yes. Passed 5-0.


