Town Manager update:

Hydro-Vac and lift station generator hookup - Parts ordered. Work slated for 2 – 3 weeks out.

Gravel Seal Cracking – Scheduled for Wednesday the 24th (contingent upon the weather)

Tree Removal – contractor has yet to sign contractor agreement but did submit a quote. Rick is requesting quotes but needs more time to complete the trees and sidewalk work. Council agreed to give Rick 60 days to get quotes and have the dead wood removed, overhanging limbs removed from Dayton Road and limbs removed around electrical wires. Mike made motion to have the trimming of the tree and the sidewalk repairs completed by 8/17. Steve S. 2nd. Steve S., Rocky, Carla and Mike – Yes. Marc – No.
